

Caseload and Mortality

Since October 2006 to July 2010; I performed an excess of 300 major liver and pancreatic procedures, over 500 minor biliary procedures. Thanks to dedication to my job, attention to details, experience and team work; during these years I demonstrated excellent results in terms of a very low completion rates and a significantly low mortality rate 1/300 (0.06%). My case load is listed as follow. This table does not include a large number of procedures performed during my training
